

As part of that celebration, we'll be presenting a brand-new **Kentucky Voices play**: *The Iron Baby Angel*. The play is an adaptation by **Robby Henson** of a book by **Charles R. McDowell**, who grew up in Danville, went to *Centre College*, and later became an esteemed law professor.

The Iron Baby Angel is set in 1909 Danville, when carts and buggies still drove down the streets, and horses were hitched in front of the courthouse to a drinking fountain adorned with iron baby angels. The book, and now the original play, is filled with local legend, lore and colorful characters from Danville's own past! It's a funny, heartwarming Tom-Sawyer-esque story for the whole family; a homage to small town America where "rare friendships grow like tender mosses on a shaded wall."


